- List Beloit College, Title IV Code # 003835 in Step #6 of the form.
- Submit for processing by March 30, 2012.
- Make sure both you and one of your parents have a federal PIN number which is your required electronic signature.
If you and/or your parent do not have a federal PIN number, go to www.pin.ed.gov for further instructions.

Step 2: Complete this form and return it to the Beloit College Financial Aid Office by March 30, 2012. Please answer all questions and do not leave blanks.

If you cannot meet the March 30 deadline, we ask for a written request for an extension prior to March 30. If an extension is needed, please send an email to faoffice@beloit.edu with your name and the date by which you will file the FAFSA and/or complete this form. Applications received after March 30 without a request for an extension will be considered, although any Beloit College gift aid will be reduced by 25%. Applications received after August 3 are ineligible for Beloit College gift aid consideration for the fall semester; applications received after November 2 will not be considered for Beloit College gift aid during the 2012-13 academic year.
