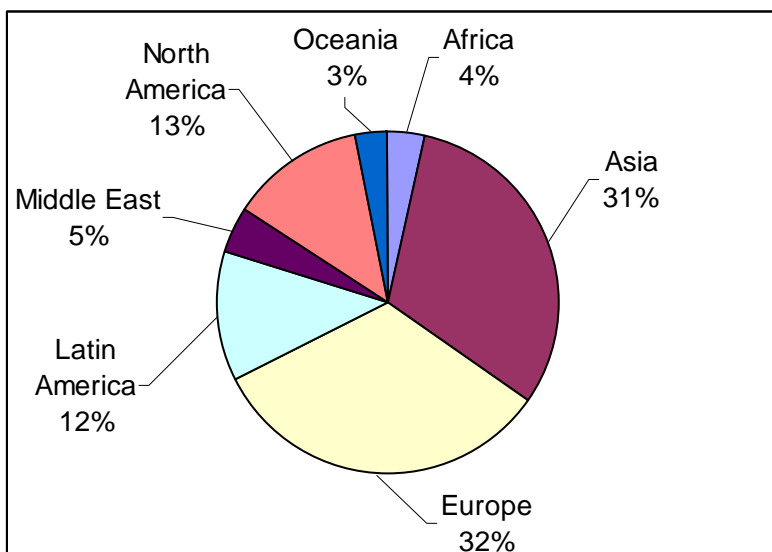


Fast Facts About Beloit's Alumni

As of September 12, 2007, Beloit had 12,652 contactable alumni; 12,054 reside in all 50 states and the District of Columbia, while 598 live in 90 different countries. The 5 countries with the highest number of Beloit alumni (excluding the United States) are: Canada, Japan, the Bahamas, Germany, and Malaysia. Information about the Classes of 1998-2007

In the last 10 years there have been 2772 graduates of Beloit College. The following are some statistics of interest about this group:

- 60% were women.
- Approximately 9.3% were domestic minorities, 8.7% were international students, 0.5% did not provide race/ethnicity information, and 81.6% were white.
- The 5 most common majors were: Psychology (10%), Anthropology (7.9%), Creative Writing (7.8%), Sociology (7.3%), and History (6.8%).
- Approximately 18% graduated Cum Laude, 14% Magna Cum Laude, and 8% Summa Cum Laude, while approximately 13% were elected to Phi Beta Kappa.
- 12.5% participated in the Educational Development Program/Student Support Services or the McNair Scholars Program.
- 6.3% received teacher certification.
- The average cumulative GPA was 3.209.
