WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Any person with disabilities or health-related needs entitled to testing accommodations under the ADA

ACCOMMODATION POSSIBILITIES

- Time
 - Extended time or breaks, stop-the-clock breaks
- Food/Drink
- Separate Testing
- Large Print, Magnification
- Braille, Screen Readers, Scribes, Tactile Materials
- Spell Check, Excel spreadsheets
- Other*

REQUIRED PAPERWORK

- Candidate Form
- Evidence of Disability
- Statement of Need
 - *Documentation needed depends if requesting accommodations for the first time, based on previous standardized tests, or previous LSAT approvals

REVIEW PROCESS

*Be mindful of registration deadlines!

1. Register for test **FIRST**
 - a. Online, phone, paper
2. Submit request and **all** supporting documentation
3. Obtain response within 14 business days
 - a. Review decision letter and appeal instructions online if needed
