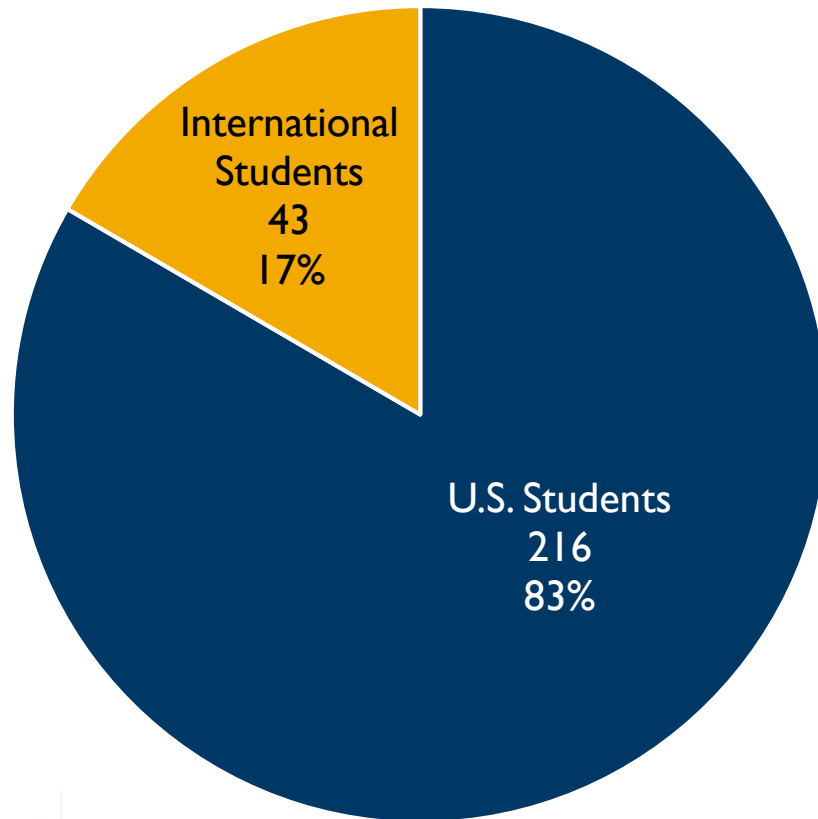

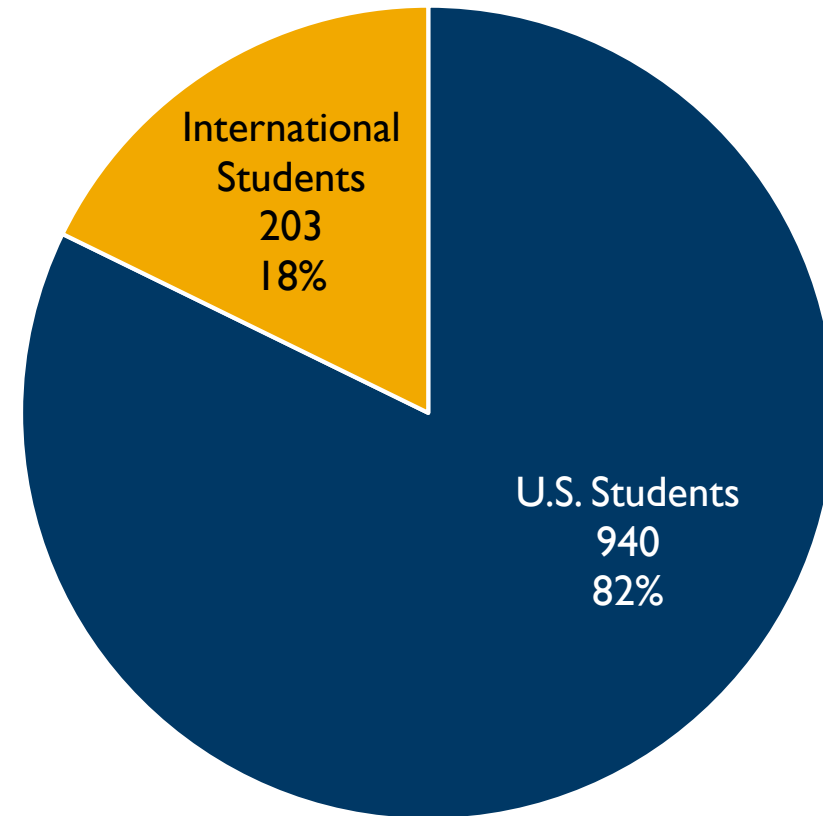

FALL 2019 INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ENROLLMENT

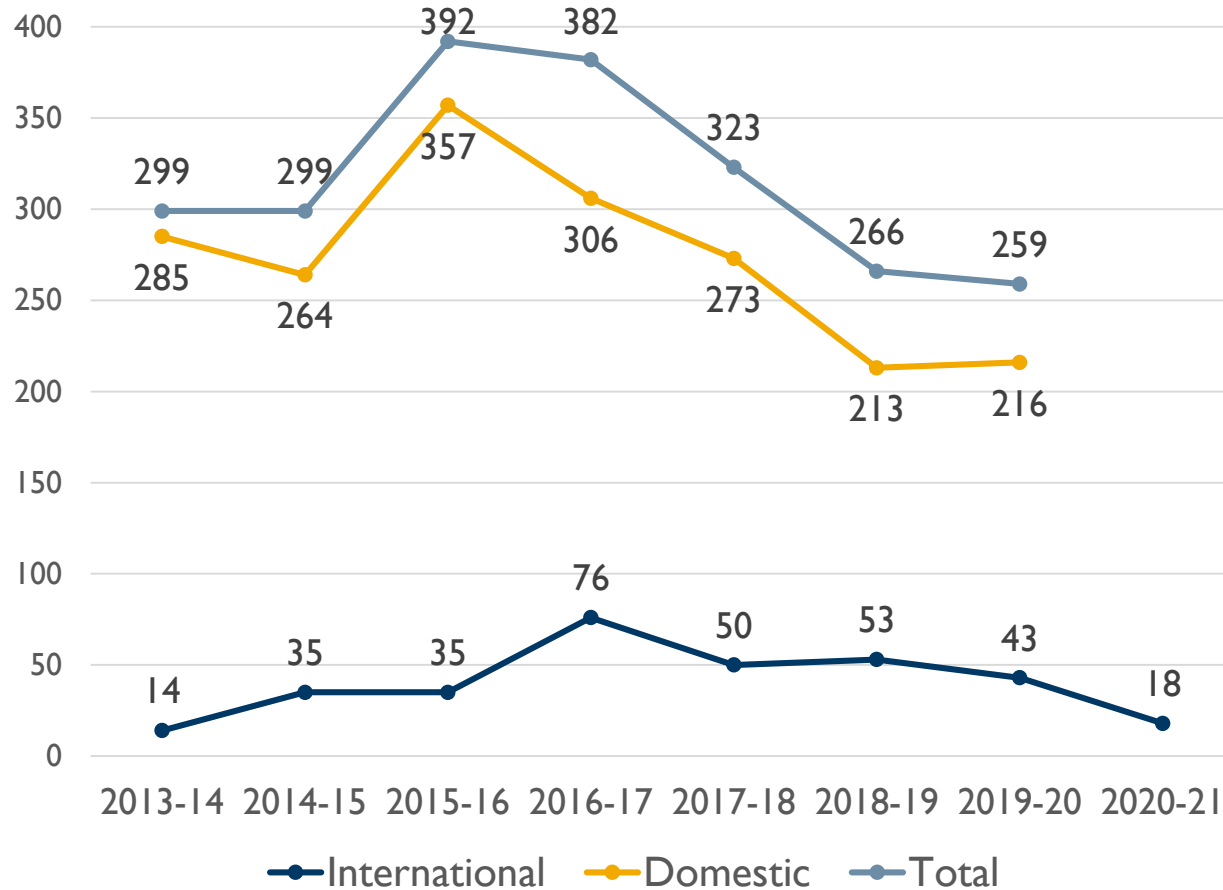
First-Year Degree Seekers

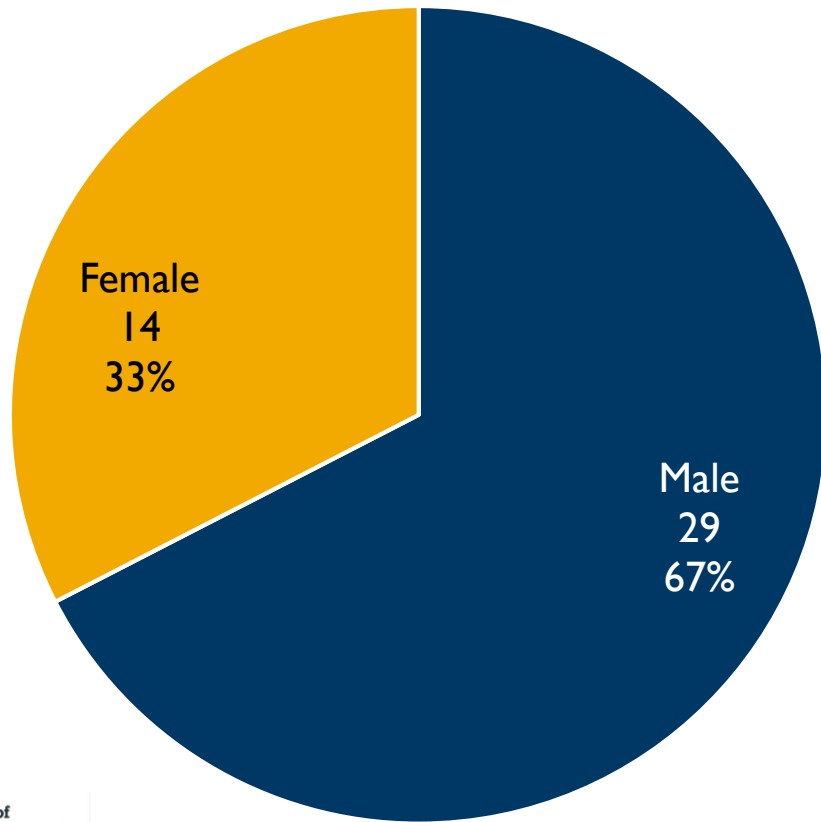
- 35 deposited degree-seeking international students

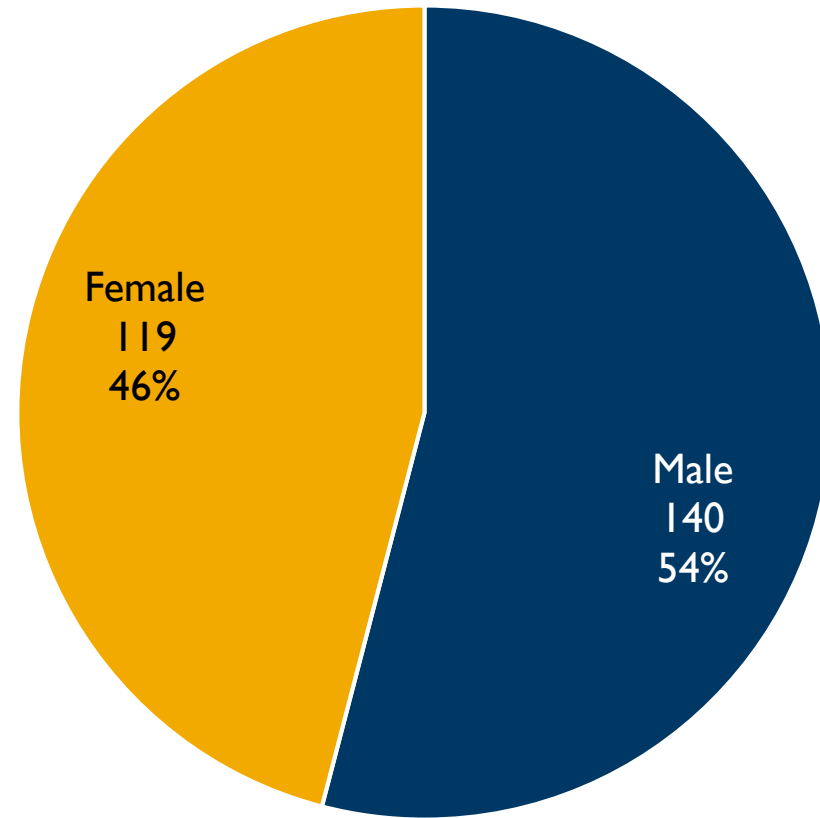

New First Year International Students



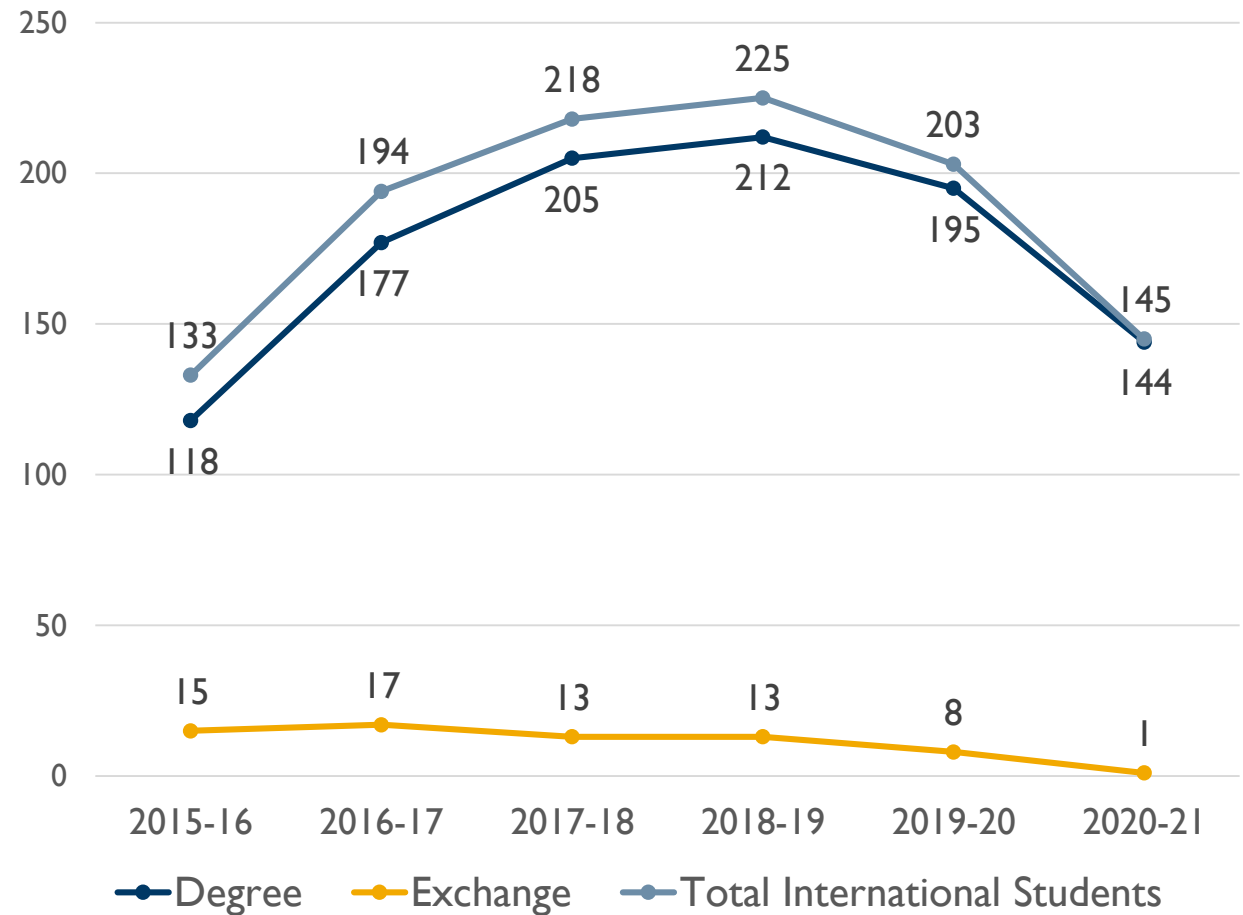
All New First Year Students



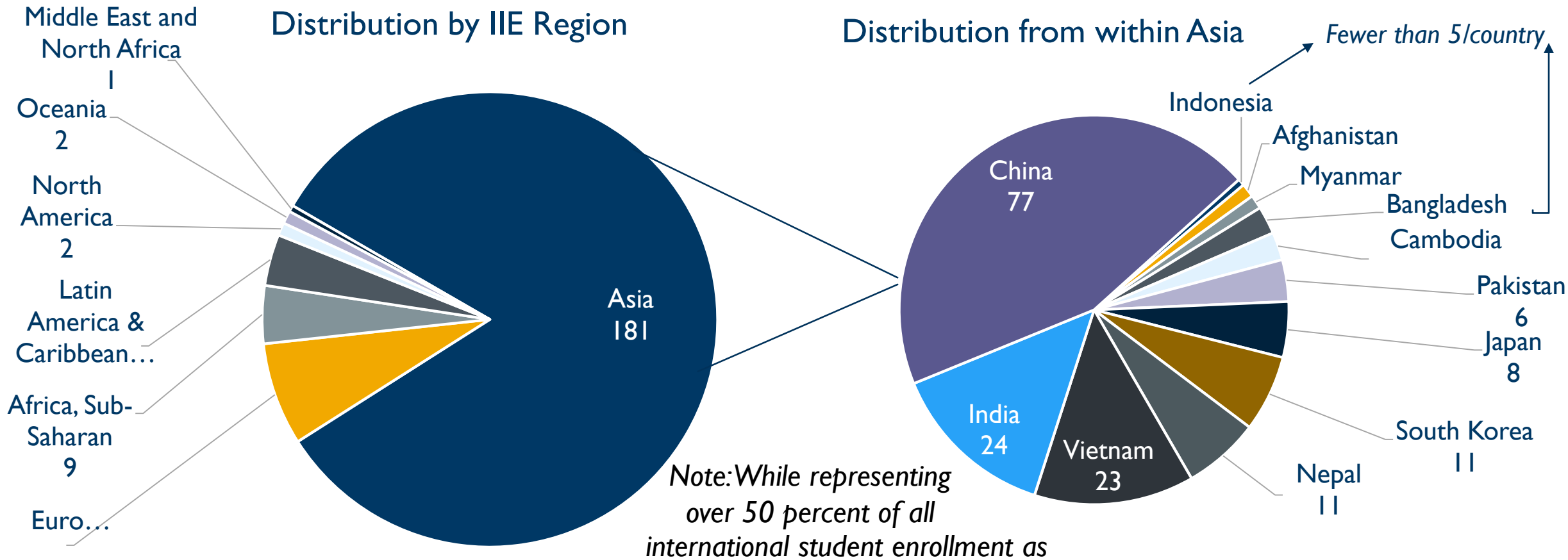
INTERNATIONAL ENROLLMENT TRENDS (2015-2020)

Why has international student enrollment decreased for Fall 2020?

- Larger than usual number of international graduates in May 2020
- COVID-19 Impact
 - New students unable to obtain visas
 - Continuing students choosing to take vacation terms.
- Continued decrease of inbound exchange enrollment correlates with decrease in outbound exchange participation.

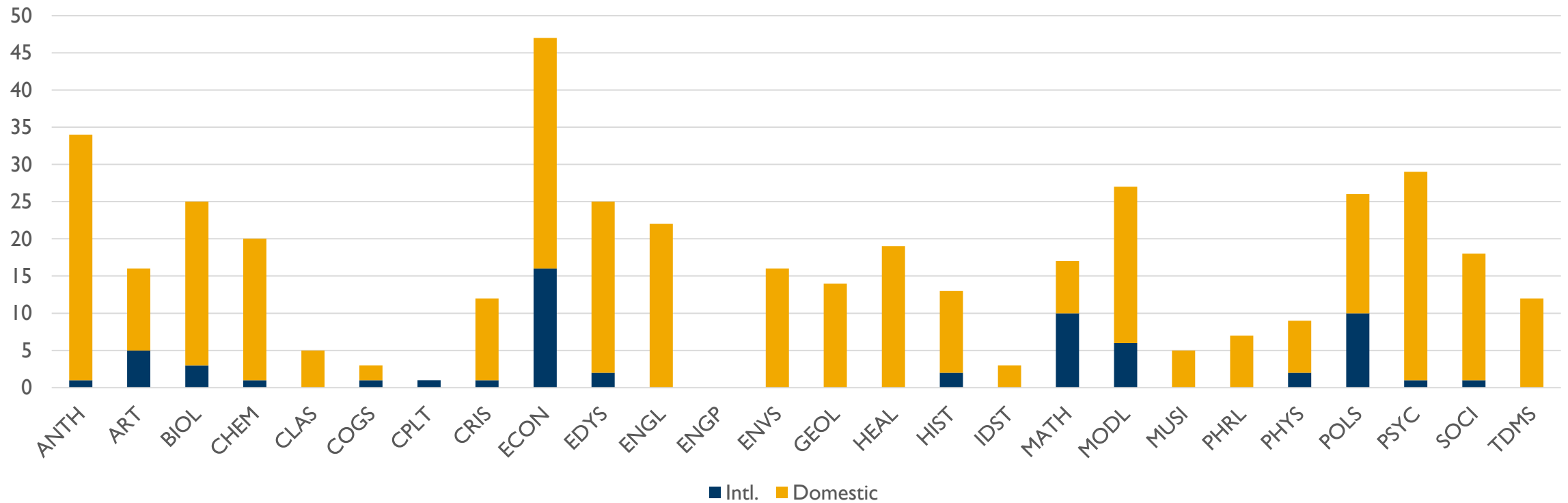


ENROLLED INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS BY REGION 2019-20

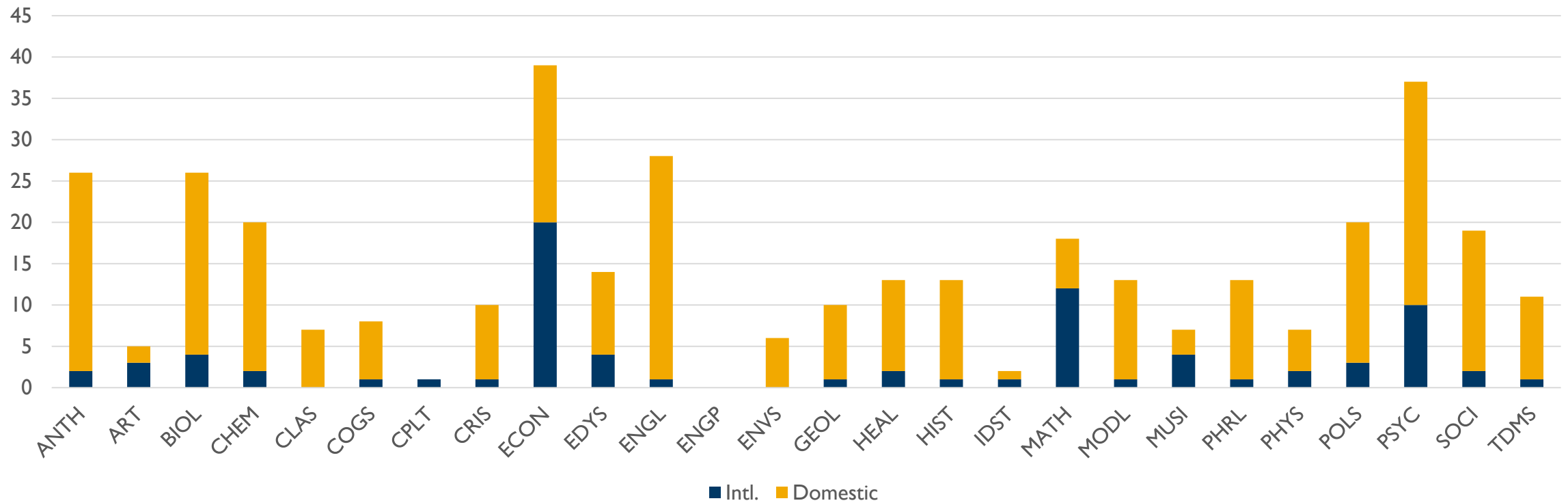


recently as 2016, in 2019-20 Chinese student enrollment accounted for only 45% of all students from Asia, 38% of overall international student enrollment. This decreases more in 2020-2021 with total enrollment of students from China dropping to 45 students total (and just 3 new) or 30% of international student enrollment.

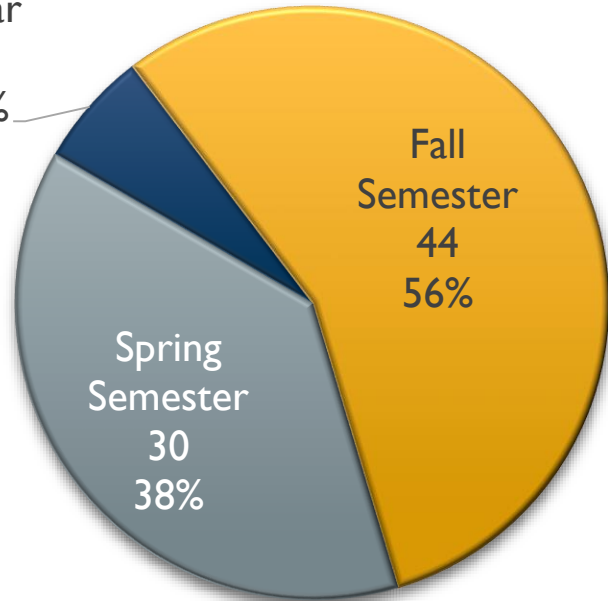

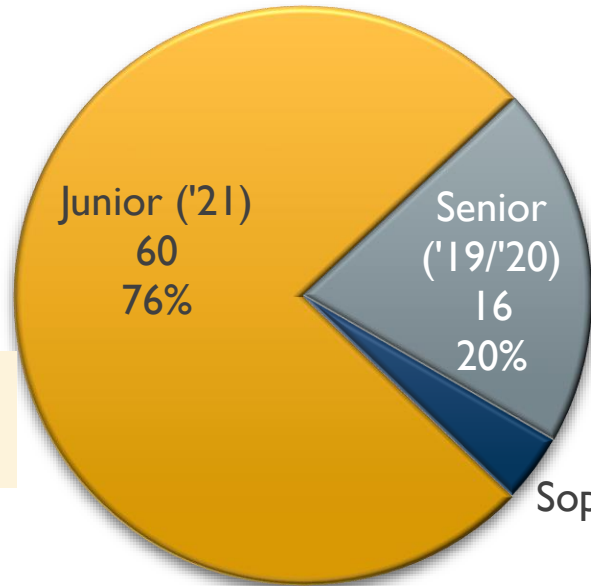

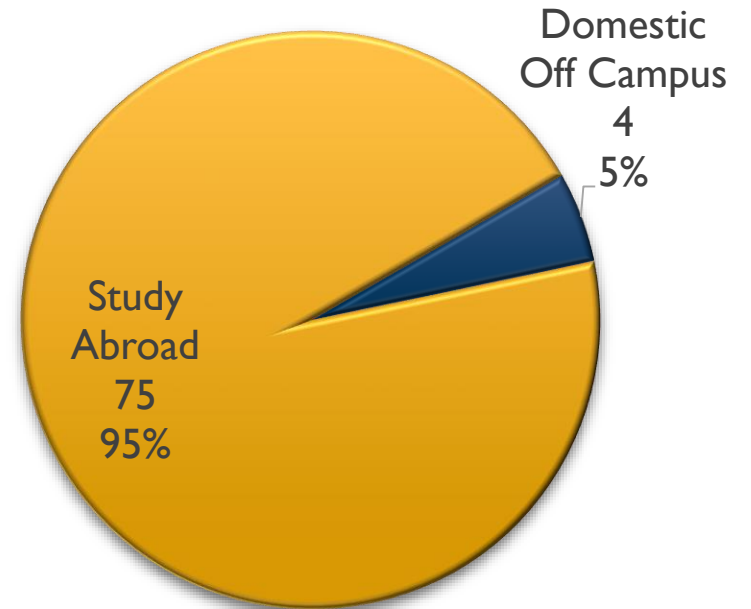

By Class Year

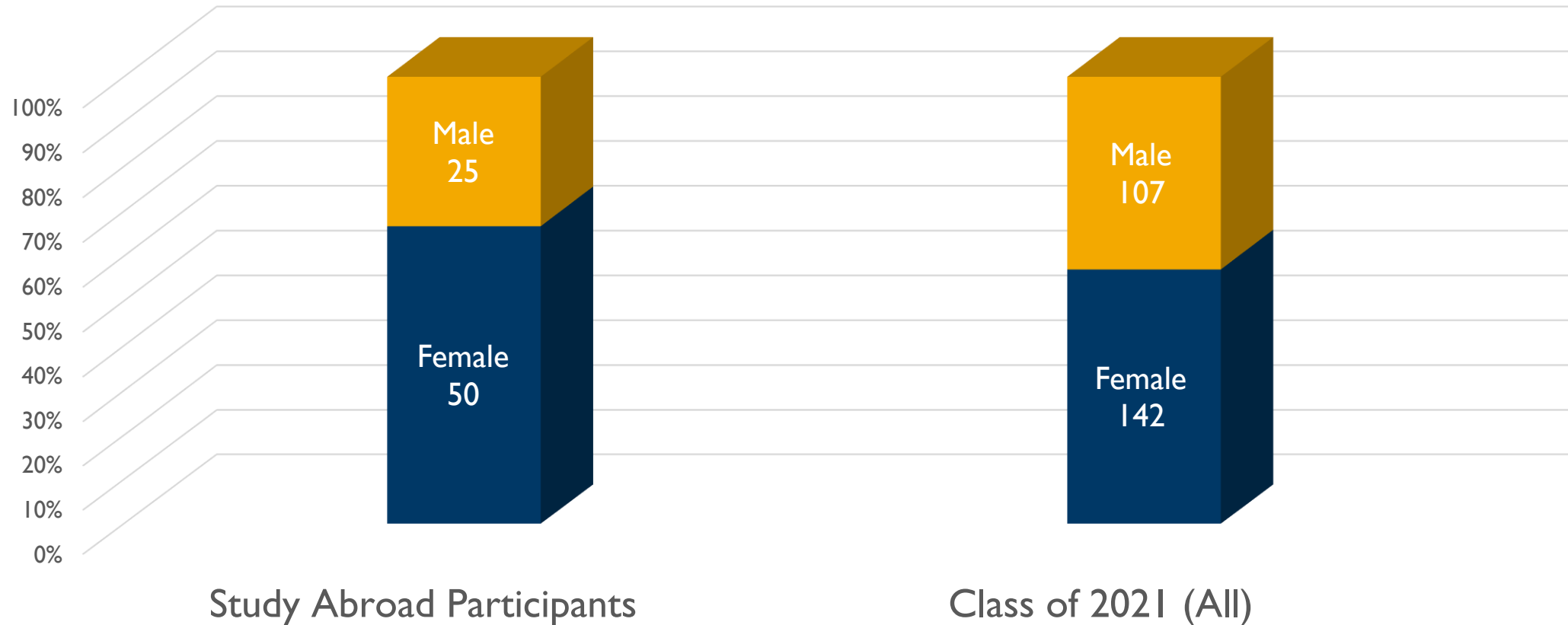


By Study Abroad/Domestic

STUDY ABROAD PARTICIPATION BY GENDER

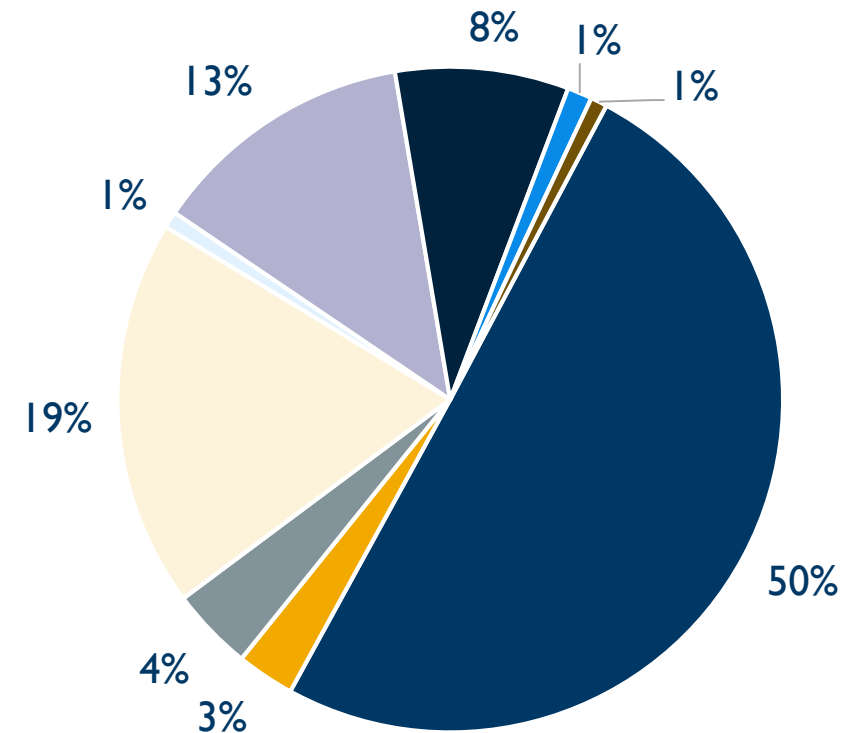
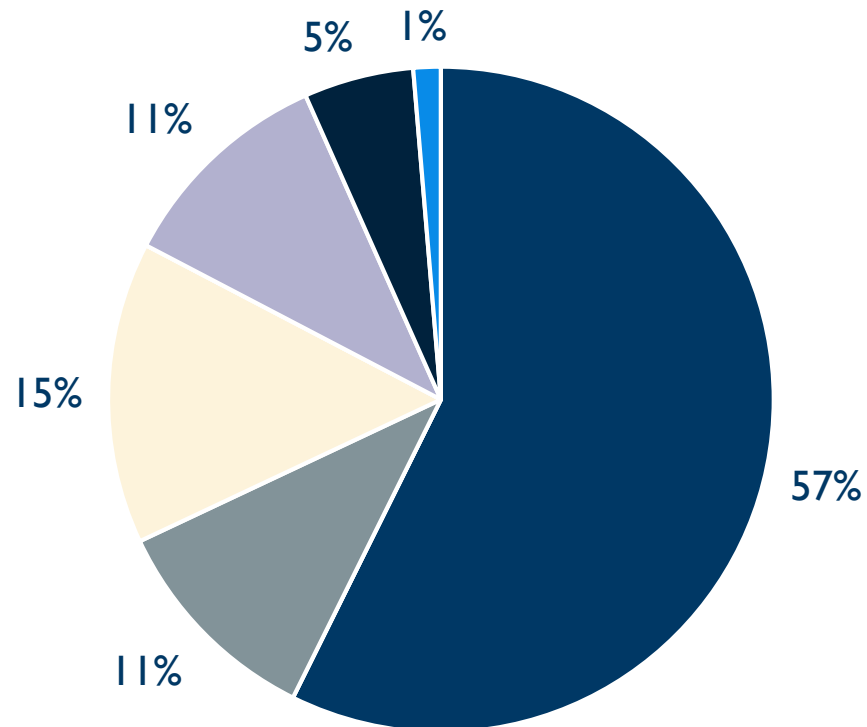


Gender patterns in study abroad match national patterns.
Gender reporting methods are binary due to data collection methods.

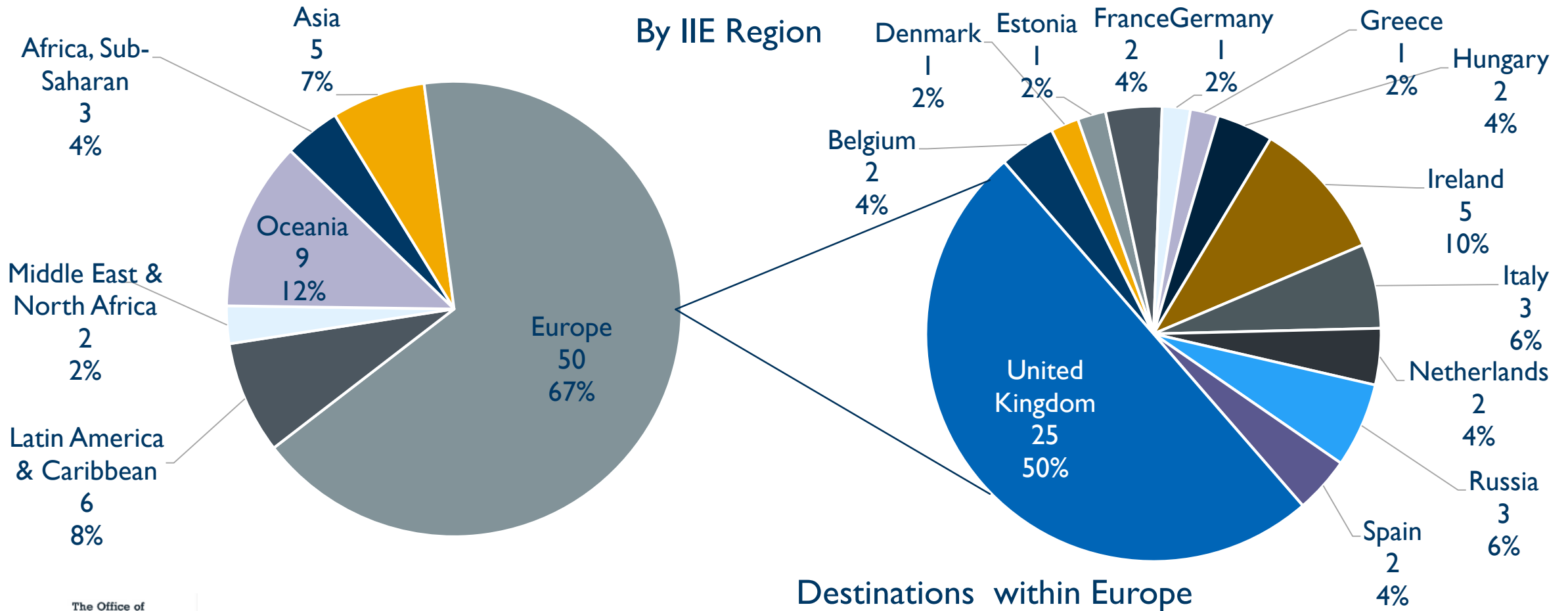
OFF CAMPUS STUDY BY RACE/ETHNICITY/CITIZENSHIP

Study Abroad Participants 2019-20

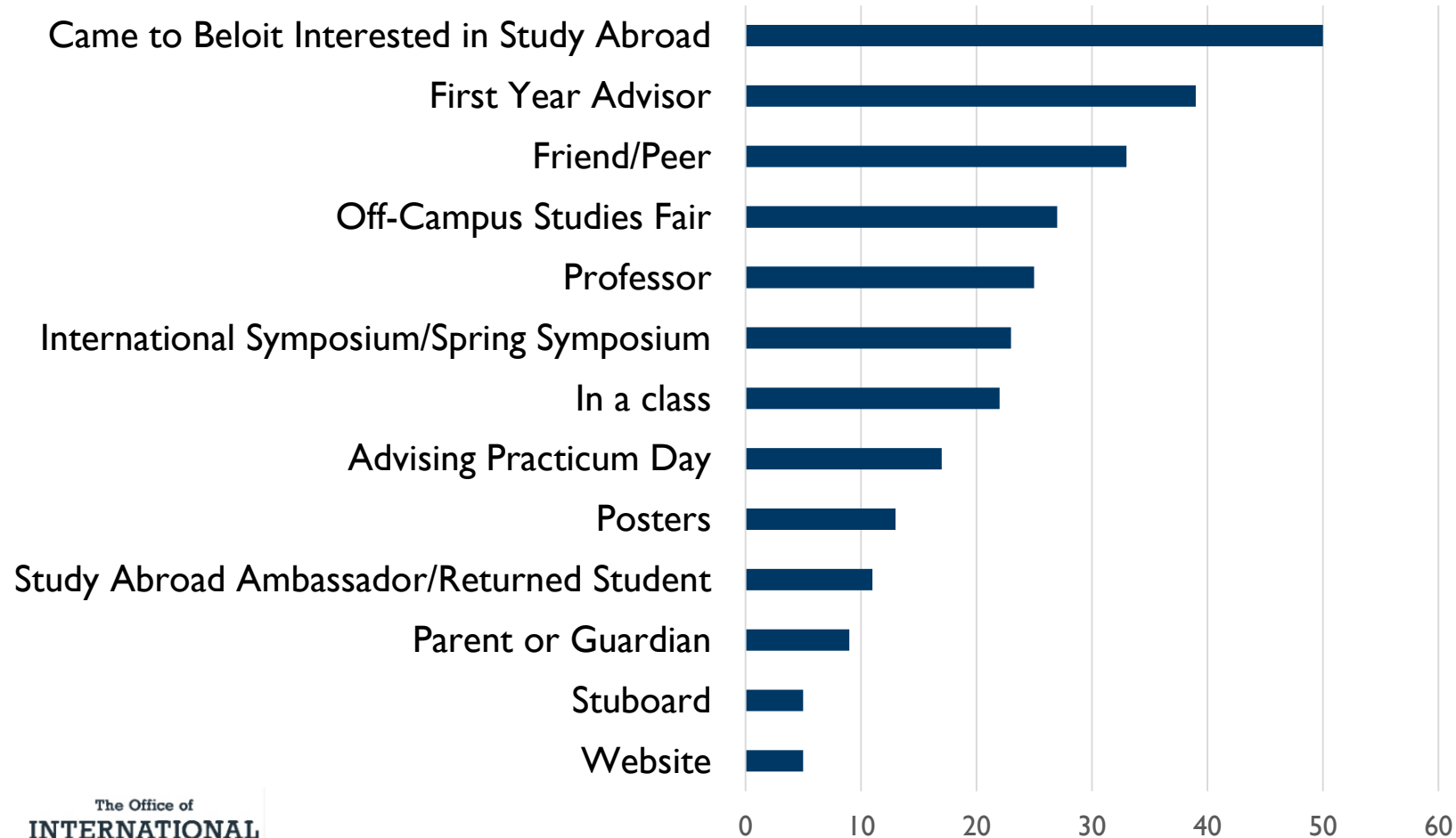

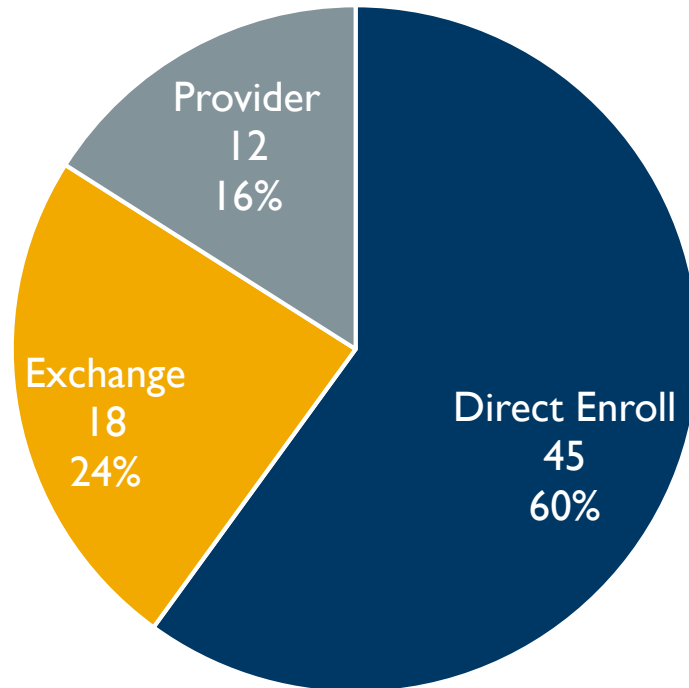


Responses are collected from initial Study Abroad interest form and are typical of previous years.

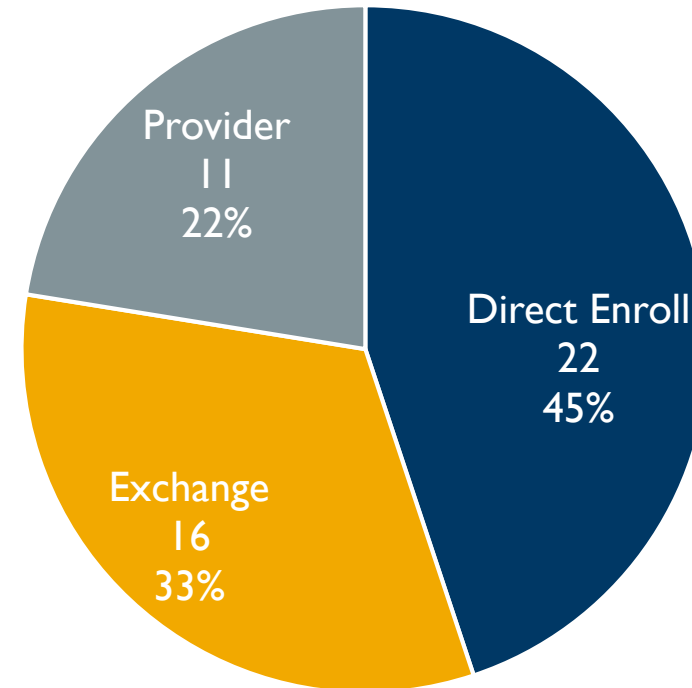
Classes/Professors are key sources of information. These are especially important for those who did not come to campus already interested in Study Abroad.

Academic Year 2020-2021 (Projected)*



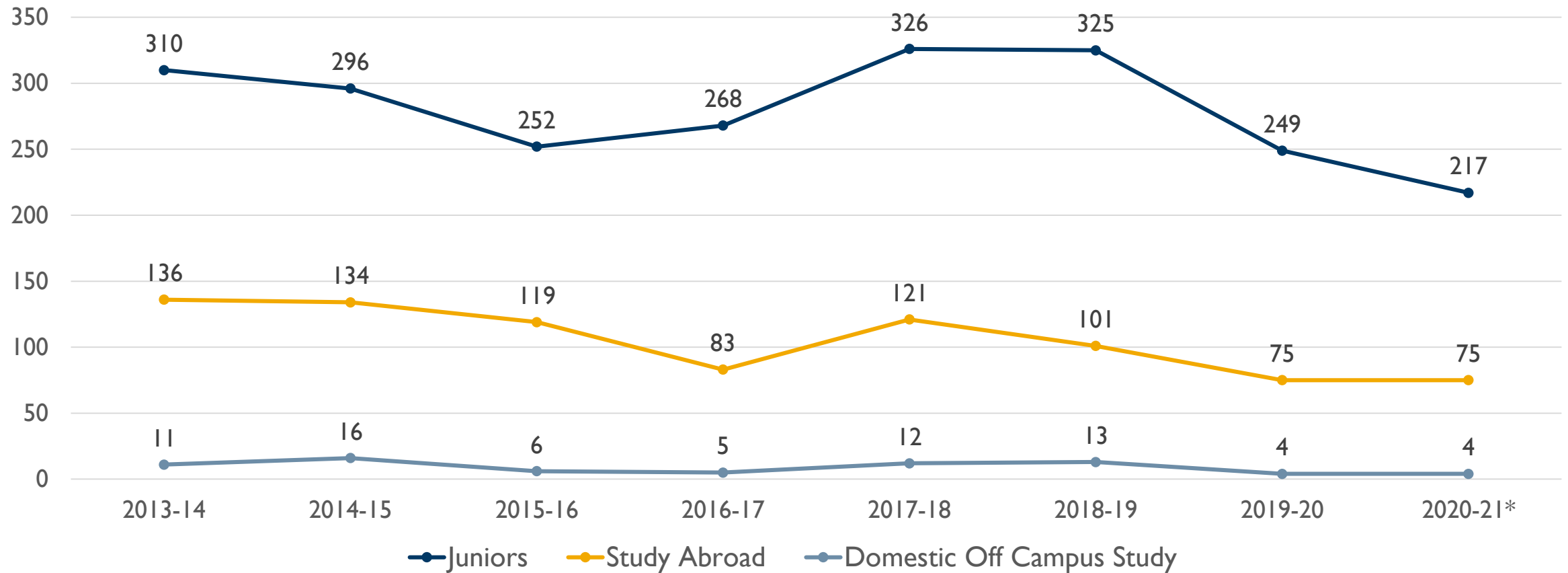

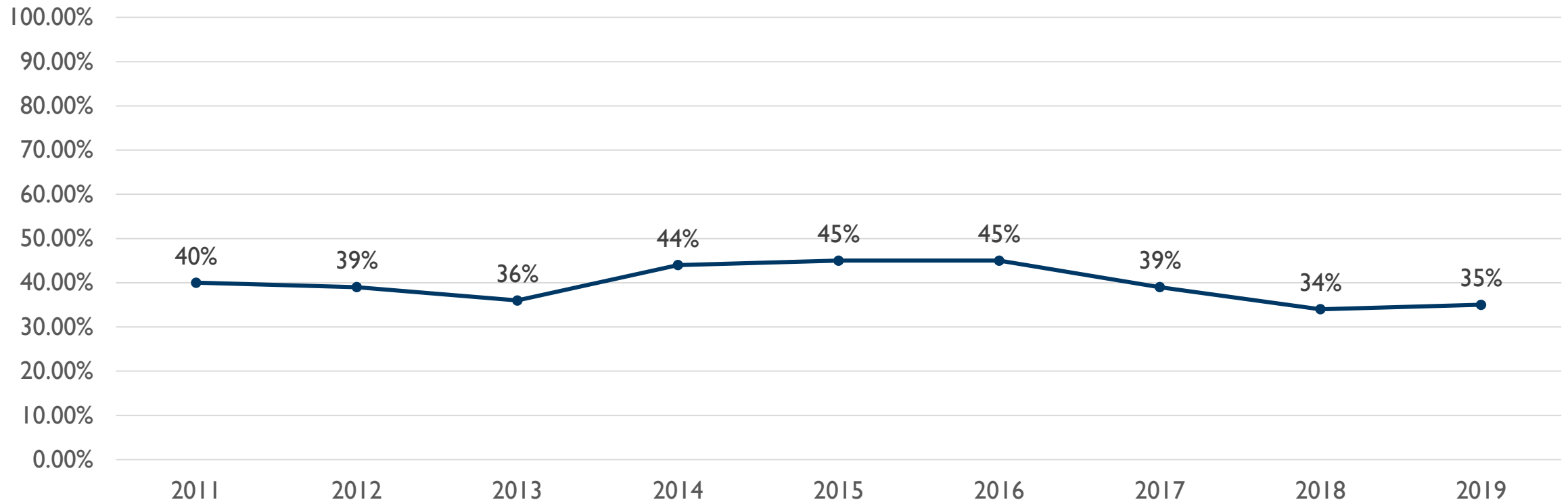

STUDY ABROAD/OFF CAMPUS STUDY PARTICIPATION 2013-2020



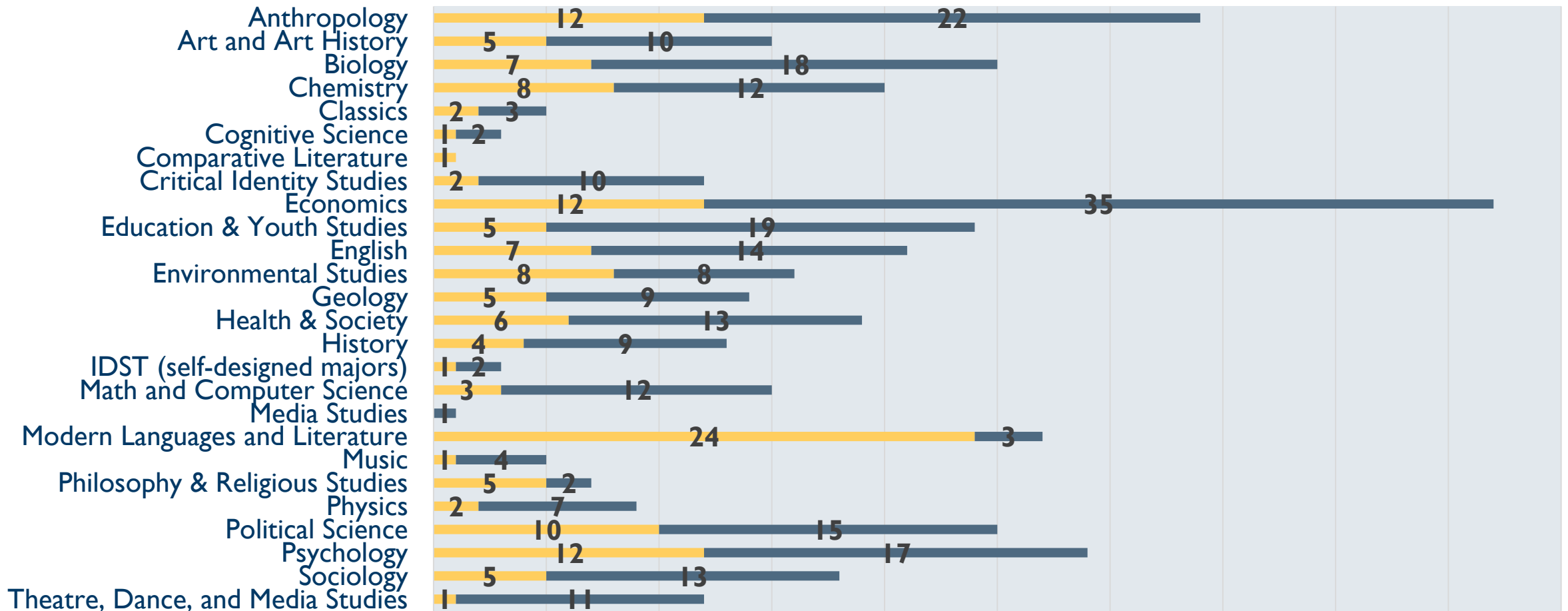
